1. RULES, ELIGIBILITY AND EVENT CLASSIFICATION

- **1.1** This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing.
- **1.2** The regatta is open to all sailors of Hansa Liberty, Hansa Liberty Servo, Hansa 303, RS Tera, and Laser Classes.
- **1.3** Each participant in the regatta will have to fill out a Release of Liability Waiver and Emergency Contact Form found here and linked within the Entry Form: https://forms.gle/CL62ibtdW6cYMaVF8 before being allowed to participate. These forms are available on the BAADS website.

2. ENTRIES, REGISTRATION, COMPETITORS' BRIEFING

- **2.1** Race entries: Entry Form will be posted on: www.baads.org/racing. Skippers should register as soon as possible, but in no case later than 1700 hours on Tuesday, July 29, 2025.
- **2.2** Skippers unable to access the registration website may register by emailing racing@baads.org or leaving a message at 415-281-0212
- **2.3** Entries shall include the skipper's first and last name and the desired boat class: Hansa Liberty, Liberty Servo, 303, RS Tera, or Laser.
- **2.4** Hansa boats will be provided by BAADS. RS Teras and Lasers will be provided by South Beach Yacht Club.
- **2.5** Rule 40.1 shall apply. Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.
- **2.6** The Regatta Organizing Committee has sole discretion for assigning boats and determining who will sail if not enough boats are available to satisfy demand. The

Regatta Organizing Committee may ask competitors not to sail the same boat two days in a row.

- **2.7** Mandatory Skippers Meeting will be held on Saturday, August 2, 2025, at 1030 hours in the South Beach Harbor Community Room. Penalty for absence is discretionary (DP.)
- **2.8** Final check in of entered skippers and boat assignment will be made at the mandatory Skippers Meeting on Saturday, August 2, 2025, at 1030 hours.
- **2.9** A \$60.00 entry fee is asked of each sailor but may be waived for hardship.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- **3.1** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and online by Wednesday, July 30, 2025.
- **3.2** Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official notice board located in the South Beach Community Room no later than 1100 hours on each morning of the regatta

4. RACING AREA AND COURSES

- **4.1** Race Area will be the waters near South Beach Harbor.
- **4.2** Courses will be windward leeward with possible reach legs. All marks used will be temporary marks, and courses will be distributed at the Skippers Meeting and with the Sailing Instructions.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- **5.1** Six races are scheduled, three for each day of the regatta. One race shall constitute a regatta.
- **5.2** The first warning signal each day shall be made at 1300.
- **5.3** No race will start after 1600.

6. SCORING

6.1 When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her one worst score. This changes Appendix A.2.

7. MOMENTOS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS:

- 7.1 Hansa Liberty Class (which includes Liberty servo): First, Second and Third Places
- 7.2 Hansa Liberty Servo Class: First, Second and Third Places
- 7.3 Hansa 303 Class: First, Second and Third Places
- 7.4 RS Tera: First, Second and Third Places

7.5 Laser: First, Second and Third Places

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

8.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
